

KEBA AG wins the Austrian state prize for Quality 2004 in the large company category

On 14th October 2004 KEBA Chief Executive Karl Kletzmaier accepted the Austrian Quality Award 2004 in the Orangery at Schönbrunn.

The Austrian Quality Award was conferred by the AFQM (Austrian Foundation for Quality Management), a member of the Quality Austria Group, in the "large-scale" and "small and medium-sized companies" categories.

Austrian companies are honored with the Austrian Quality Award for consistent pursuance of the so-called 'Principles of Excellence'.

The structuring and awarding of points enable a direct comparison of the applicants. The jury, comprising experienced managers and experts from the industry, had the difficult task of choosing from a great many applicants again this year.
